



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q:** What is the cost to attend?

**A:** \$8,700 for 2026-2027 school year. The cost includes tuition, books, and registration fees.

**Q:** What is the deposit/registration cost?

**A:** \$500 non-refundable

**Q:** Does the school accept the Education Freedom Account (EFA) funds?

**A:** Yes

**Q:** Is there be a monthly payment plan?

**A:** Yes, there is fee schedule provided to each family.

**Q:** Is there financial aid available to help with the cost?

**A:** There are some scholarships available. There is a financial aid application online.

**Q:** Are shot records required for enrollment?

**A:** Yes. We have to follow the State Board of Health for all childhood immunizations. However, Immunization Exemptions granted by the Arkansas Department of Health are accepted.

**Q:** Will additional grades be available in the upcoming years?

**A:** The plan is to add additional grade(s) each year. The goal is to be a K-12 school.

**Q:** Is there an afterschool program?

**A:** There is an option for afterschool care for an additional fee.

**Q:** Is there be a dress code?

**A:** Yes, modest attire including shirts with school logos, jeans or dress pants without holes. This is defined more in the student handbook.

**Q:** Are extra-curricular activities available (music, art, p.e.)?

**A:** Yes. It is incorporated in the curriculum

**Q:** What curriculum is used in the classroom?

**A:** Abeka

**Q:** Is there an end of year exam for the students?

**A:** Yes, every student will take the Stanford 10 exam.

**Q:** Are meals provided?

**A:** No meals are provided. Students will need to bring lunch from home.

**Q:** How will discipline be handled?

**A:** This is not a reform school. There is no corporal punishment. Discipline will be addressed more in the student handbook.

**Q:** Is special education services provided?

**A:** The school is not equipped to handle the needs of students with special needs at this time.
